Picnic Details

- Parents are warmly invited to bring a picnic to share and enjoy with their children.
- Please note that **alcohol, smoking, and vaping are strictly prohibited** anywhere on the school site.
- Both school gates will open at **12:00pm** for entry. However, the **Penshurst Avenue gate will close at 12:15pm** for safeguarding purposes. After this time, please **exit via the Winthorpe Road gate only**.



Collecting Your Child

- Please collect your child from their **usual end-of-day collection point** so staff can sign them out before you find a place to sit on the field.
- If you plan to **take your child home after the picnic**, please inform the class teacher when you collect them.
- If you are **unable to attend**, your child will remain with their class teacher until **2:00pm**.
- If your child is in **Year 4 to Year 6** and you are **not attending the picnic** and would like your child to leave unaccompanied, please complete this [form](#). Without this permission they will not be allowed to leave on their own.
- Learners will **not be allowed to leave on their own until 2:00pm**.



School Grab Bags

If your child is in **Reception to Year 2** or is in receipt of **Free School Meals**, you can order a school 'grab bag' lunch by completing the form by **12:30pm on Tuesday 15 July**. This helps us prepare the correct number of meals.



Health & Safety Notice – No Football

To ensure a safe and inclusive environment for all, **football will not be permitted** during the picnic.



In Case of Bad Weather

If the weather is poor, the picnic will be held **indoors** for children only. Unfortunately, **parents will not be able to join** the indoor picnic. In this case, you may collect your child **any time from 12:00pm** via the school office. We will notify you on the day if this change is necessary.
